


## Conditions of Let

1. Maximum booking is 12 people.
2. All accommodation must be paid for.
3. Any damage and breakages must be reported to the Custodian ASAP. Damages must be paid for.
4. The Hut must be secured whenever it is left unattended and on departure.
5. The Fire Precaution (Notices on display in the Hut) and Fire Safety advice must be observed.
6. The Departure Routine (per Notices) must be followed.
7. The person booking the Hut accepts the above Conditions on behalf of the party he or she represents and agrees to indemnify the Ceunant Mountaineering Club against any loss or claim arising as a result of occupying the Hut in breach of these Conditions.

### Access & Disabled Access

One key is supplied to the front door. There are 2 further external doors which open from inside the hut. Please ensure all doors are locked on departure and when the hut is left unattended. There are disabled toilet and shower facilities and access throughout the ground floor.

### Accommodation

Outside bookings are restricted to a maximum of 12 people in the large room to the right at the top of the stairs. Use of the hut is not exclusive and 2 bedrooms are reserved for Members of CMC only at all times. Sleeping bags are required. There is a separate lounge, dining room and hall for boots, bags, etc.

### Facilities

The hut has electricity, hot and cold water, heating, showers and toilets including disabled facilities.

### Heating & Drying

The hut is fitted with central heating and has a separate drying room in the corridor to the bathrooms. Due to rising costs of fuel please use the heating respectfully.

There is a log fire in the lounge. **Hut users must bring their own wood** (logs not coal please). Wood can be bought from the following:

Jack: 01286 870718 £3/bag—can be purchased & delivered in advance.  
Llanberis: Spar & Cost Cutter both sell wood.

The heating & hot water switches are located on the left by the front door. Ensure heating is switched off over night & whilst hut is empty & both are switched off before vacating the hut.

### Kitchen Equipment

This includes 2 fridges, oven, microwaves, kettles, 4 gas hobs and 2 grills. Cooking utensils, crockery, glasses, cutlery and food storage area is provided. Please note the timer has to be set on the oven before it will work—simply press the clock button twice.

Please ensure you leave the fridges clean and switched off at the end of your stay. Although we aim to provide toilet rolls we do not get up to the hut every week so you are advised to bring your own supplies. **It is your responsibility to leave the hut clean and tidy at the end of your stay.**

### Charges

£30.00 non refundable deposit  
£8.00 per person per night

### Payment & Key Return

Return the key and payment promptly following your stay. Cheques should be made payable to Ceunant Mountaineering Club and sent, along with the key secured in an envelope, to Ms H Holmes at address shown on reverse.

### Availability

The hut may be booked by any club affiliated to (or by an individual member of) either the BMC or MCofS, or otherwise, as approved by the Ceunant Mountaineering Club.

### Smoking

Smoking is not permitted in the hut at any time.

### Local Amenities

**Gear shops:** Llanberis and Betws Y Coed.  
**Food/beer:** Spar, Llanberis or Tesco, Bangor  
**Petrol:** Betws Y Coed or A4224 toward Bangor just outside Llanberis

### Fire Prevention & Safety

A heat detector is fitted in the kitchen which is linked to all the smoke detectors. There is emergency lighting throughout and exit points are marked. Before retiring for the night the log fire should be checked and inflammable objects adjacent to it removed to a safe distance. All Fire Doors should remain closed at all times. Fire extinguishers are provided along with a fire blanket in the kitchen.

### First Aid

There is a first aid kit stored under the stairs. Any items used should, within reason, be replaced. The nearest A&E department is Gwynedd Hospital, Bangor, LL57 2PW.

### Refuse Disposal

Bins are only collected every fortnight so every effort should be made to burn and minimise rubbish or to remove it at the end of your stay. Bin bags are provided but not guaranteed.

There are recycling bins under the kitchen worktop for glass, cans and plastic. Recycling facilities are available in Llanberis—1st right after Royal Victoria hotel, in car park. Please take all recycling to this facility or take home on departure.

### Parking

Spaces are available to the right of the hut in front of the church. Ensure the church gates are kept clear at all times.
